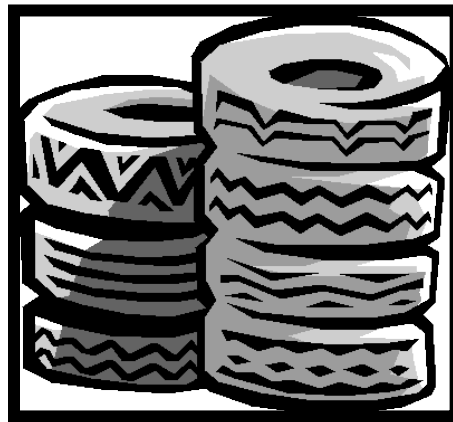

Recycle Livingston will be celebrating Earth Day this year by hosting a tire recycling event. We can collect 500 tires per event. So it is important to register. We would love to host future tire recycling events so should you not be able to make it to this event, no worries. We will schedule another event soon if the demand is there.

Silver Lining Tire Recycling will be collecting the tires for recycling. Scrap tires are a very real liability issue. Every year in the U.S., over 300 million tires are discarded, causing a huge disposal problem and environmental concerns ranging from toxic fire hazards to mosquito breeding grounds. Silver Lining Tire Recycling has a system to recycle the tires into tire mulch. The mulch is environmentally friendly and looks like shredded bark. However it does not fade, naturally repels insects and lasts much longer. You can call them at 734/342.4800 if you are interested in purchasing tire mulch.

Tired of Mailbox Clutter? Here is something you can do!

It is called **CATALOG CHOICE**. The website –www.catalogchoice.org was developed by the National Wildlife Federation, the Ecology Center, and the Natural Resources Defense Council. Their goal is to improve the efficiency of catalog distribution by reducing the number of repeat and unsolicited mailings, saving trees, and reducing carbon dioxide emissions in the atmosphere.

It is estimated that some 53 million trees are harvested annually to produce the 19 billion catalogs currently making their way to our mailboxes. For all the folks who feel they do not know how they can make a difference in Global Warming—here is one way to make a positive difference.

All documents will be shredded on-site by American Data
Securities**

**Members can bring in (2) banker boxes free of charge
Non-Members can bring in (2) banker boxes with \$3 gate fee
For an additional fee of \$3 per box, (6) more boxes will be accepted**

**Business Members can bring in (6) banker boxes free of charge
For an additional fee of \$3 per box, (20) more boxes will be accepted
Non-Business Members can bring in (6) boxes with \$10 gate fee
For an additional fee of \$3 per box, (10) more boxes will be accepted.**

As of March 1st, 2016 Recycle Livingston's policy for accepting the following materials will be:



VHS/DVD/CD/Floppy Disc/Cassette Tapes

This material can only be accepted at the office trailer for a fee of \$.30/lb by appointment or on site days. There will be a minimum charge of \$1.00. This material must be free of any plastic covers, cardboard or paper sleeves. The covers can be recycled with plastic, paper, or boxboard. Recycle Livingston has been paying to recycle these materials for some time and this fee does not increase revenue for Recycle Livingston. It will simply cover the cost to keep these materials out of the landfill. American Data Securities is our new vendor and they will be recycling every part of these materials. Please call 517.548.4439 to schedule an appointment or simply bring the materials in during our hours of recycling. Thank You so much for your continued support.

Year Round Confidential Documentation Shredding Now Available

You can now bring any paper documents that require shredding to Recycle Livingston all year long. Paper can be accepted on all open site days and by appointment on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please call us at 517.548.4439 for appointments and large volumes. The cost will be \$.50 per pound.

American Data Security Inc. has provided a locked, secure container for paper drop off that is located in the office trailer. This container will be picked up every other week and all materials will be shredded immediately upon removal by American Data Security. We can provide certification from American Data Security. Recycle Livingston will continue to hold annual on site shredding event in April for large volumes.
